The brick wall to the Theatre entrance is going to be repaired, as it currently is in a very dangerous position. My thanks to Jack Barker for attending to this. The brick wall is going to be strengthened with steel to make this more secure. Plans for the new patio to the Green Room entry are being drawn up now to submit to the council. We should see a start to this project shortly. This will give us more uncover area for Winter & Summer to protect us from the elements. The retaining wall built by the council has finally been completed. All we have to do now is to back fill this area with loose material to help with drainage. We propose to do this before the start of the winter. I'm still obtaining prices for the Stage Flooring & hope to present this to you at the A.G.M. in February.

We didn't do so well in the Finley nominations this year, but it's all about participation not awards. My congratulations to those who have been nominated & I wish you all the greatest luck at the Awards Night. The new vinyl in the Kiosk, Toilet Entry & now the Make-up area is going to be laid at the end of the month. This was painted previously but the door was replaced shortly after due to its poor state. We can't complain about the council, they have been tremendous to us. They have spent a tidy sum lately in putting things right & I congratulate them in still believing in our Theatre & for being so approachable to me especially.

Roleystone Theatre Committee – a selection of roles and portfolios:

President

The role of the President is to preside at committee meetings to ensure that the business of the Club is carried out. As President you are the Chief Executive Officer of the Club. The committee makes policy and determines objectives. You carry out the directives of the committee and make things happen. You appoint and oversee the operation of all of the club committee. You help committee members to have good meetings, recognize efforts and accomplishments of others, obtain good publicity, grow the membership & have good communications. Being President is a “growth” opportunity as you face challenges and overcome them with successes. The ability to get the best out of others will result in a fun, thriving club. The primary purpose is to help others succeed.

Vice President

- In the President’s absence the Vice President shall be Chairperson at all meetings.
- In the event of the office of President becoming vacant, the Vice President shall preside at all meetings of the Society and shall perform the functions of the office of President until the election of President at the next Ordinary or Annual General Meeting.
- Support President where and when needed.
- As per general committee

Other portfolios:

- Gardening
- Maintenance
- Stage and lighting liaison
- Social events
- Callboy postage
- Cleaning
- Archives
- Publicity

Secretary

- Check and obtain rights for future productions and fill in relevant forms.
- Enter shows into the Finley Awards if requested.
- Liase with charity groups re: preview nights.
- Liase with Treasurer for payment of rights for productions.
- Collect, read, respond to or distribute mail.
- Write letters as per committee instructions.
- Take Committee meeting minutes and distribute to committee
- Have show materials delivered to director/relevant person and when show has finished collect all materials and return to rights provider/theatrical agent.
- Liase with Life Members re: voting on shows.

General Committee

- Six or more members elected at a General Meeting shall constitute a quorum.
- The Committee shall, where possible, implement the constitutional majority decisions of a General Meeting.
- The Committee shall allocate finds for productions.
- The Committee shall purchase capital equipment as needs arise and funds allow.
- The Committee shall allocate positions of responsibility as the need arises.
- The Committee shall formulate rules and regulations as required, providing such rules and regulations do not contravene this Constitution.

Membership

- Maintain master membership list (excel spreadsheet)
- Collect new (paid) membership forms from treasurer
- For each new show, liaise with production team and cast/crew to ensure all are members before opening night
- Send versions of membership list to callboy editor and printing company and ticketing officer each month

Website

- Collect relevant information for website updates e.g. from committee meetings, callboy
- Check that season dates and show details are correct
- Review website regularly, to check for out of date content
- Liase with website administrator to request updates be made
