
The Embankment Stabilisation at the rear of the Theatre has finally been completed.

The end result is very pleasing, although it was a very dusty process. There has been some damaged caused by the heavy machinery to the ground but this has been reported to the council and hopefully rectified.

As you can see by the photo below the steps from the cast car park thru to the Green Room earthworks have also been completed. Brett Tomlin (City of Armadale) has met with the concreter to discuss laying the concrete for the path. Hopefully a start on this is imminent.

I personally am thrilled by the work carried out by the City of Armadale. There has been so much discussion in getting this project of the ground and a few sceptics, but it is all done & dusted. It certainly is a huge improvement to how it was. Each year the embankment was rapidly getting worse and it is with piece of mind to us all that it has finally been rectified.


