NEW ROOF


Work has commenced on replacing the Theatre Roof. Initially this was going to be on just over the Auditorium as this was deemed to be the most urgent. This section on the roof was well and truly passed its use by date.

The other section was clad with an inappropriate roof profile, which gave us a lot of problems over winter. The council has decided to replace the entire roof with the correct roof coverage, due to the fact that it has a very shallow degree of pitch. New guttering is also being installed as well as insulation. The cost to the council is approx \$40,000.00.

As you are all aware that during winter we get an awful lot of rain, which leaked into the dressing rooms & men's toilet. You only have to look at the photographs provided to see that we do have a lot of roof, exposed to the elements. This type of roof generally has a life span of 25 years. This should see us out for quite a few more years.

My sincere thanks must go out to the Council in arranging for its replacement. Another thing we don't need to worry about.
