I have been in contact with the council, and have requested an on site meeting. This meeting will take place on Wednesday 6th September. So far the council have asked for a consulting engineer to come up with plans & costings for the retaining wall along the side of the theatre. Also an electrical engineer will need to do the same for the rewiring of the old part of the theatre. The new proposed walkway has been already looked at by the council and ideas will also be discussed. I will let you all know the outcomes of the meeting, but rest assured the committee is working hard in getting things done.

The damaged light pole in the theatre car park has finally been replaced with a new one. It's a shame that whoever hit the pole didn't own up to it. The theatre is having a display at the Karragullen Expo on the 16th September, so if you plan to attend please spend some time helping out. We will have our usual display of Photos and hand out leaflets promoting our coming attractions. Bobbie & Gerry have worked hard bringing the Old Time Music Hall together. Working with Children Check

Although the **Working with Children Check** started on the first of January 2006, it is being rolled out over five years. This affects when we need to apply for checks, depending on what age the children are indicates the year in which we need to apply for the checks.

This is as follows: Children 0-7yrs - 2006

8-12yrs - 2007

13-17yrs -2008

After 2008 checks will apply to all adults working with children of all ages.



Who needs to apply?

This depends on each individual show and the directors will need to liase with the Youth Development Committee Member to decide who will need them. Under our insurance we are all deemed to be volunteer workers and this includes all of our membership regardless of age. Therefore adults who are in a production with children (eg Annie, Oliver) are not required to have checks. Anyone who is deemed to be 'tutoring the children' i.e. the Director and Assistant Director must have one. We must decide on a show-by-show basis if people such as Music director or Choreographer need one which will really only be if they individually 'tutor' children. In regards to junior or teen workshops then all adult 'tutors' must have a check.
