Duke Bluebeard's Castle

A Kékszakállú herceg vara

Play in one act by Béla Balázs [adapted into English by Paul Treasure]

Duke Bluebeard – Lee Wright

Judith – Kristen Twynam-Perkins

Directed by Paul Treasure

Duke Bluebeard's Castle was written in 1908 by the Hungarian poet Bela Balazs (1884-1949). In 1911 the play was turned into an opera by Bela Bartok, but wasn't performed until 1918. After that first production it was neglected until its first revival in 1936. Since then it has become one of the more popular operas of the twentieth century, and certainly the most popular Hungarian opera ever.

The play takes as its source material one of the bloodiest of Charles Perrault's classic fairy tales. In the original version Bluebeard marries his young bride and gives her the keys to his castle, warning her that she is allowed in every room except one. Her curiosity gets the better of her and she opens the forbidden door only to find the bloody corpses of his previous wives. Unfortunately the key becomes bloodstained and she is unable to wash off the blood, so is soon found out. Bluebeard threatens to kills her and... it eventually ends happily ever after.

Originally one of Perrault's most popular tales it has fallen out of favour in the last fifty years because it is almost impossible to make "suitable for children". This version has given the story a more psychological reading, and it becomes an extended metaphor about male/female relationships, and the dangers of knowing too much about a partner.


